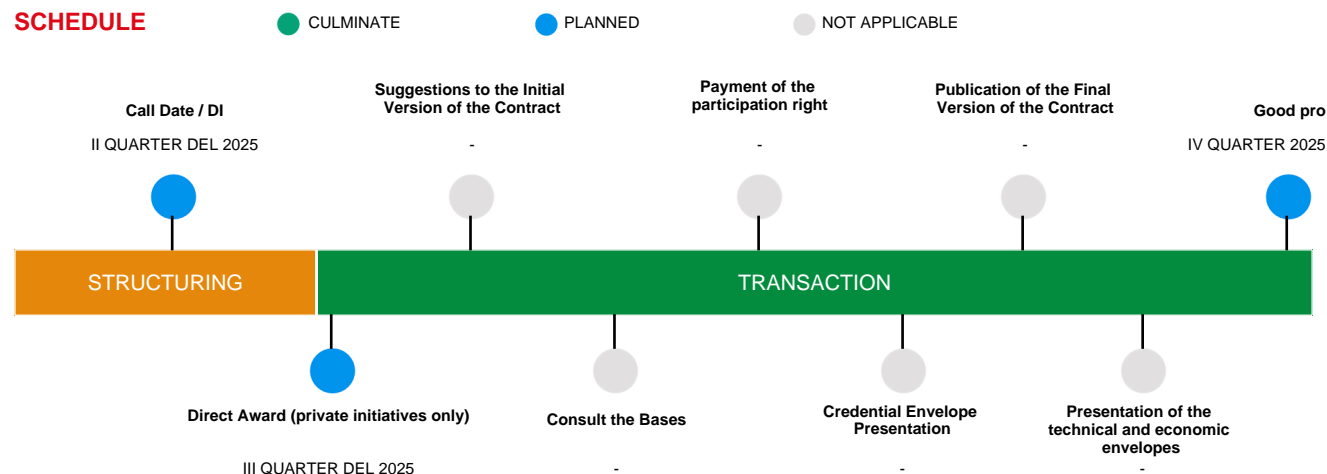

RESUME

The project for the New Central Military Hospital aims to design, build, maintain, and operate a state-of-the-art hospital for the Army, adhering to sustainable certifications such as LEED 2009. The medical (green gown) and non-medical (gray gown) services will be concessioned, covering areas such as hemodialysis, clinical laboratory, sterilization, and maintenance of equipment and infrastructure. Additionally, complementary services like technology, food, cleaning, security, and waste management will be provided. Located in Jesús María, the hospital will ensure continuous care with provisional infrastructure during the construction phase.
